You already played against Shanghai and lost, what are you going to change for tomorrow's match?

The tournament in Shanghai was a very difficult match. Three sets were played and, to be honest, I was dominating. However, in the end, he showed his best version and managed to take the victory. But tomorrow the conditions will be different: there will be more humidity and the court will be slower, so we will see what happens. A final is always different from a second round.

Alejandro, Acapulco and this tournament have a special connection with your country. In its 32 editions, players like Rafa Nadal, Carlos Moya and David Ferrer have won. What would it mean to you to win the title?

Obviously, it would be very special. If I manage to win, it would be a great honor to join the list of players you mentioned. In the end, the first title is always special, no matter where you get it. If I have the opportunity to achieve it here, it would certainly be even more meaningful to me.
